Executive Committee Business Meeting

The executive business meeting was called to order by Jay Busby at 6:52 PM. Present at the meeting were Jay Busby, Daryl Amble, George Stilwill, William Karch and Bill Bright.

A primary membership applications for Ross Mendenhall and Patrick B. Spears was presented for acceptance by Bill Bright. George Stilwill made a motion to accept the new members with a second from Bill Bright. Motion passed.

Daryl Amble made a motion to adjourn the executive committee meeting at 6:54 PM. Motion was followed by George Stilwill. Motion passed.

General Business Meeting

The General meeting of Kern Shooting Sports was called to order by President Jay Busby at 6:58 PM.

- 1) The minutes from April 20th, 2022 were presented for errors. George Stilwill made a motion to pass the minutes as written. Daryl Amble followed with a second. Motion passed.

PRESIDENTS REPORT: JAY BUSBY

2) Workday

- a. Cook shed- Jay and Eddie will look at the floor and edges and seal the cook shed.
- b. Hunter safety sea train door needs to be sealed. It was suggested that conveyor belting could be used.

- c. Canopy material has been replaced. Another workday will be needed to put shade material on the sides.
 - d. Score shed needs repair. (Wood rot and door seal.) It was suggested that metal siding be put on the exterior walls and painted with exterior paint. Cost will be researched.
 - e. Shooting benches need to be re-finished. Jay Busby spoke with people that he knows that deal with a lot of wood working about the best way to seal the tables for long term. It was recommended to use oil based Kilz (primer) and follow up with 3 coats of Urethane.
 - f. Target shed in the pit needs to be painted or have metal siding installed on it also.
- 3) NRA grants have been applied for:
- a. 2022 Family Fun Day Grant has been submitted by Daryl Amble.
 - b. 2022 NRA Foundation State Fund (Rifle Program) Grant.
 1. Grant 22CAS014 has been accepted with exceptions.
 - c. Pistol Grant application has been submitted. No response back yet.
 - d. The NRA grant has been submitted for the 2021-2022 Shotgun program.
 1. Grant has been denied.
- 4) The club has started to list the firearms for sale on Gun Broker.com.
- a. No response from John Kaiser lately.
- 5) Kern Shooting sports will be offering the sale of three throwers to the club members. Repairs need to be made to the throwers. Throwers are old models.
- 6) A request was made for an increase for the cost to maintain the club's website. Issue was tabled to look at other options.
- 7) Shiloh Darrow has offered to manage the social media account for Kern Shooting Sports. (Facebook, Etc.) Shiloh Darrow was not available at the meeting. It was mentioned that all information needs to be the same across all media platforms.
- 8) A battery tender needs to be purchased to maintain the batteries for the shotgun program. George informed Jay that there was money in the shotgun account to purchase the battery tender.

VICE PRESIDENTS REPORT: Daryl Amble

- 1) Daryl thanked those that helped with Family Fun Day.
- 2) It was suggested that an additional sign be purchased for .22 arcade.

- 3) Daryl made a request to be reimbursed for the clays purchased at the Bakersfield Gun Club for the April shotgun program. Request was not needed and Daryl had already been reimbursed.
- 4) The final day for the shotgun program will be June 25th, 2022.
- 5) There will be a high power match on June 25th, 2022 also.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Bill Bright

- 1) Watch for rattlesnakes.
- 2) No steel core rifle ammunition is to be used at the range until further notice. Rifle ammunition will be checked at the top of the hill.

TREASURERS REPORT: George Stilwill

- 1) Financial Report was presented. Starting balance of \$10,831.06 with an operating fund of \$14,533.79. The Family Fun Day account has an outstanding balance due to a one time purchase of banners and signs. A motion was made by Daryl Amble to zero out the outstanding balance for Family Fun Day account and accept the treasurers report followed by a second from George Stilwill. Motion passed.

- 2) Justin Welch from the National Rifle League (NRL) spoke with club about the club joining forces with the local NRL.
 - a. Matches would be Sunday mornings once a month for 9 months. (June to February)
 - b. Matches would have separate classes. (Basic, open, adaptive, etc.)
 - c. Matches consist of 5 stages.
 - d. Justin would provide a target set for the matches.
 - e. KSS will need to register on NRL22.org. And pay an annual fee of \$20.00. An additional fee of \$35.00 would be paid to register the results of each shoot.
 - f. KSS would insist that at least 2 Range Safety Officers (RSO) be present at each match. More would be preferred.
 - g. KSS membership would be needed. (That would require NRA membership.)
 - h. All shooters would be required to pay the 5 Dogs range fee.
 - i. A packet of information was provided by Justin.
